We come as we are.

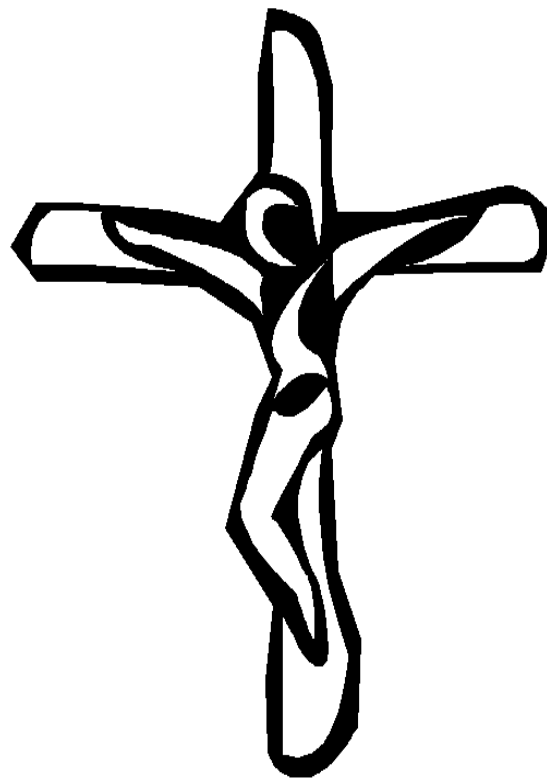
Song: **OPEN MY EYES**
