

"Effective today, all graduates of an Edmund Rice Christian Brother high school who are admitted to Iona College as first-time full-time freshmen, will be eligible to receive the Christian Brothers Legacy Scholarship, which will provide a minimum of a 50% tuition scholarship to Iona College, renewable each year contingent upon continuous full-time undergraduate enrollment at the College!"


