

Perú UPR

Coordinator

Perú's UPR (Universal Periodic Review) will be reviewed at the United Nations in early 2023. Edmund Rice International is coordinating a written submission for this which is due by June 30, 2022. Edmund Rice Latin America Defensoria Edmundo Rice Coordinator Paola Miranda, and ERCBNA Advocacy Coordinator Dr. Sean D'Alfonso are coordinating a joint submission from both Latin and North America. Their efforts will bring together schools and other stakeholders who both live in or have been involved in immersions in Perú with Brother Stephen Casey, to learn about the UPR process and make recommendations to the U.N. There will be a Zoom meeting in March that schools are welcome to join, during which they can learn about the UPR process and how they will be able to contribute to the submission. The link to this Zoom meeting will be sent to ERCBNA school Advocacy Coordinators in the near future.

UPR of Haiti



The Edmund Rice Christian Brothers North America Province joined with local partners to present a joint submission of the Haiti UPR. International Day for the Elimination of Racial Discrimination



March 21, 2022 celebrates the International Day for the Elimination of Racial Discrimination. This day was formally adopted by the U.N. in 1979, in memory of the 69 people killed by police in South Africa, after peacefully demonstrating against apartheid laws. 
